## 1. Let us know you're coming!

- 2. Stay on the marked trails (map near parking lot) and do not enter hatchery work areas
- 3. Do not feed wildlife
- **4. Be respectful near hatchery ponds;** avoid running, loud noises and ensure no rocks, sticks or food enter hatchery ponds (except fish food at fish feeding pond)
- 5. Be aware that some areas of the site may be reserved for Columbia Springs programs, like field trips or summer camps
